This itinerary takes you to four different parts of the Mara which gives a wonderful insight in to the area. Riding through rolling savannah, acacia woodland and riverine forest guests will enjoy the scenic and wildlife highlights of this quintessentially East African landscape. It is quite likely that you will find yourself cantering alongside plains game and giraffe, and when not on horseback there's the opportunity to game drive and walk.

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Days 1 and 2

This morning you are met at your hotel or at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport and driven the short distance to Wilson (Nairobi's domestic airport), where you connect with an onward flight to the Masai Mara. Your guide will meet you on arrival and will take you on a game drive to camp, arriving in time for lunch.

After a short siesta you will meet the horses and set off on an evening ride. You spend two nights at Oloiburmurt private mobile camp (Ol Kineyi Conservancy) on a full board basis to include all meals, local drinks, riding and all game viewing activities.

The next day you spend your time exploring the area on horseback. In the afternoon, there's the chance to visit a local Masai village.

Days 3 and 4

Today is move day and you set off early on the 25 km ride to the Naboisho Conservancy. The riding is over vast grassy plains which overlook the Sianna Hills and where you can expect to see wildebeest, zebra, giraffe and gazelle. There is also the chance to spot elephant and buffalo in this area. At about 1230 you stop for a packed lunch and a siesta.

Your two night stay at Enisikeria private mobile camp (Naboisho Conservancy) is on a full board basis to include all meals, local drinks, riding and all game viewing activities.

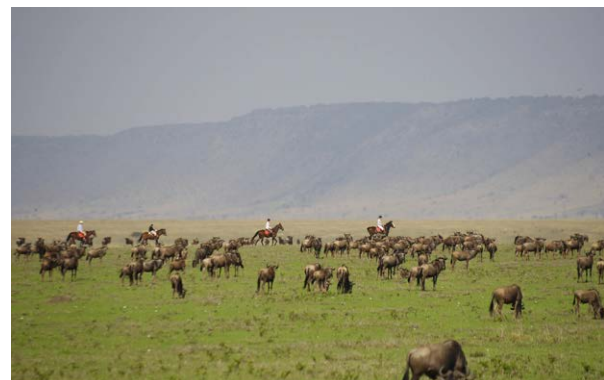
The following day you can go on a morning walk or game drive and either an afternoon ride or game drive.

Days 5 and 6

This morning you leave the Naboisho Conservancy and ride north-west through Olare Orok to Mara North, covering about 40 kms. The riding country here is flatter with some thick acacia scrubland, steep river crossings and rocky escarpments. Again you will stop for a picnic lunch and a siesta.

Your two night stay at the very pretty Oloturoto private mobile camp (Mara North Conservancy) is on a full board basis to include all meals, local drinks, riding and all game viewing activities.

The next day you can go on a morning and afternoon ride, walk or game drive.



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Days 7 and 8

You depart camp this morning and ride north-west along the river, where you can sit and watch hippo snorting in their pools. This area is rich with wildlife and you can expect to see lion, elephant, buffalo and plenty of plains game.

Your two night stay at Mara River (Mara North Conservancy) private mobile camp is on a full board basis to include all meals, local drinks, riding and all game viewing activities.

The next day is your last full day. You can go for a morning and afternoon ride, walk or game drive, with the possibility of a night drive after supper.

Day 9

This morning you have the opportunity to go on your last ride, walk or game drive before heading back to camp for a lovely lunch. You are then taken on a short game drive to the airstrip where you meet the flight back to Nairobi.

You will sleep in traditional safari tents which are located in beautiful, private areas usually under a canopy of trees or beside a stream. The mosquito-proof tents are simply furnished with either double or single beds, carpets, solar lights and bedside tables. A separate canvas shower and loo unit is placed behind each tent. You will eat delicious home cooked meals around a table in the dining tent.
